Maziar Sabet is President and CEO of Brakeley Asia. Maziar has served in a range of senior leadership positions in education and philanthropy, and has extensive expertise in Asia. He has lived in Hong Kong since 2013, and also lived in Singapore from 2003 until 2010.

He served as Hong Kong International School's Chief Advancement Officer, leading the school to historic achievements in annual fund participation, major gift fundraising and alumni engagement. Under Maziar's leadership, HKIS successfully formulated its first ever capital campaign, pioneered a grassroots, parent-led annual fund drive, increased alumni participation by over ten-fold, and oversaw the establishment of numerous new alumni chapters across Asia, Europe and North America.

Maziar also has widespread university experience. In addition to serving as an advisory board member at the University of Maryland, he was INSEAD's Executive Director for the Asia Pacific region, where one of the world's leading business schools significantly grew its presence in Asia and launched a capital campaign, resulting in numerous achievements, including what was at that time the single largest gift to the school from an individual.

During his time in the United States, Maziar worked at the World Bank as a Senior Advisor, where he focused on the organization's global efforts in environmental sustainability, and at Laureate Education as Vice President of Market Development, responsible for marketing and business development in Asia, the Caribbean, Latin America and North America.

Maziar holds an MBA from INSEAD, and has also studied at Georgetown University in the United States, Landegg University in Switzerland and Simon Fraser University in Canada.
